ANNIE OAKLEY COMPETITION: OFFICIAL RULES

The Annie Oakley is Back! Faster Play. Higher Stakes. More Competitive Than Ever.

1. Eligibility & Entry

The Annie Oakley Competition is an exclusive add-on to the main event. Participants must be registered for the Clay Shoot to be eligible to compete. The buy-in for this add-on is \$50 per competitor.

- **How to Join:** Shooters may add the Annie Oakley competition to their registration in advance or sign up on-site the day of the event.

2. The Purse & Payout

The prize purse consists of 50% of the total competition entry fees, awarded to our top two finishers:

- First Place: 60% of the purse
- Second Place: 40% of the purse

(Example: If 20 shooters enter at \$50 each, the total entry fees are \$1,000. The purse is \$500, with \$300 to 1st place and \$200 to 2nd place.)

3. The Format: Miss and You're Out

This is a sudden-death, knock-out style competition. Shooters fire in a rotating sequence. If a shooter misses the target, the next shooter in line has the opportunity to "knock them out" by breaking it. If you miss and the shooter behind you breaks the bird, you are eliminated.

4. Fair Play: Club-Supplied Ammo Only

To ensure a level playing field and maintain a controlled "ammo scene," all participants must use ammunition provided by the Club. No outside shells are permitted; this ensures no shooter has an equipment or load advantage over another.

5. Starting Position: The 16-Yard Line

To keep the match competitive and give less experienced shooters a fair chance to knock out a veteran marksman early, we begin at the 16-yard line.

6. Distance Progression

As the field narrows, the challenge increases. Successful shooters will progressively move back to the 19-yard line, then the 21-yard line, and so on, until the first and second-place winners are determined.
